Nominations

Nominations must be received no later than 12 noon Sunday the weekend prior to the scheduled race meeting

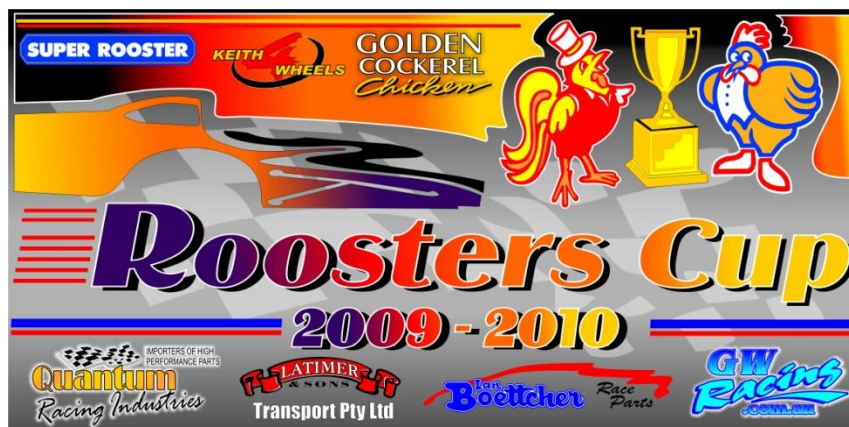
To Denominate you must contact one of the Roosters Cup Officials before Thursday 8pm. If you do not denominate before this time you will start of the rear of your heats and the feature race your next Roosters Cup round

Under no circumstances are nominations to be submitted directly to the promoter. All nominations must be received by the Roosters Cup organizers.

Please be aware that if insufficient nominations are received for any event, the prize money may be reduced and the race format may change.

The above prize money breakdown has been calculated on a field of 20 or more cars appearing at the race meeting. If less than 20 cars compete at the race meeting the prize money may be reduced or changed.

Cars that do not finish the feature race will be placed in accordance with the number of laps completed after the cars the actually finished the feature

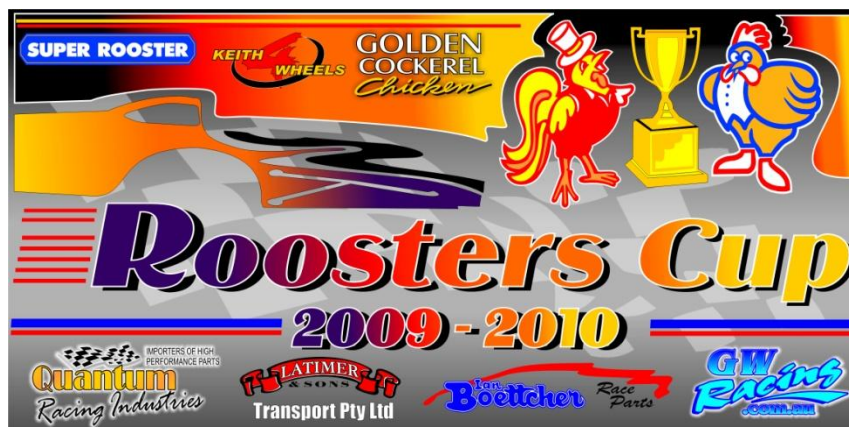
No prize money will be paid on the night of the race meeting. All prize money will be electronically transferred into your chosen bank account. All money will be paid within 5 working days

Drivers or car owners are required to give Organizers the bank account details you wish the money to be paid to. If there are any changes to your details it is important that you tell us as soon as you can.

To be a Supportive Driver you must compete at all scheduled rounds

The placing's will be determined using the points from all four rounds
Last round will be double points

Race Format

The race format for each round of the Roosters Cup will be decided by the organizers with the track promoters. However, each round will normally follow the below format.

Drivers Briefing

All drivers and cars must be at the track no later than 4.00pm. Any competitor that fails to do so may be penalized by starting at the rear of their heats. This will be at the discretion of the Rooster's Cup Organisers
Drivers Briefing will be held at 5.00pm sharp (unless otherwise advised) and all drivers must attend. If any driver fails to do so, they may be forced to start at the rear of their heats and feature no matter where you qualify, once again at the discretion of the Rooster's Cup Organisers

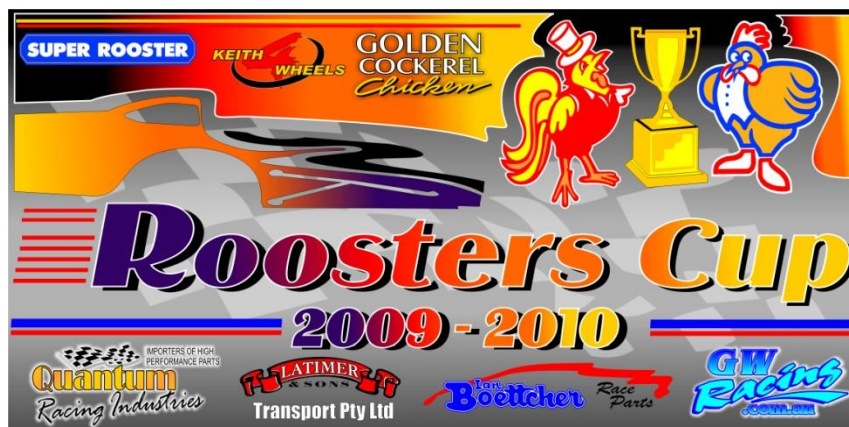
Hot Laps

You will be advised about your hot laps at the drivers briefing. Please remember that hot laps are not compulsory. They may be cancelled, reduced or rescheduled. Drivers will be in their heat groups for hot laps.

Heat Races

There will be a minimum of 2 heat races per driver depending on nominations a 3rd may be necessary. Each heat will have a minimum of 8 laps and a maximum of 12 laps. Starting positions for the 1st round of heats will be drawn out of a "hat". The 2nd round will be of heats will be a full invert





of the round 1 starting positions (e.g. heat 1; position 1 will become Heat 3, rear

Points Tie Breaker

In the event of points being tied after the heats the tie breaker will be determined on the first heats. The driver who passed the most cars will win. If there is still a tie the 2nd heat will be taken into consideration

Top Qualifier

The top qualifier will earn a \$100 bonus. They will also be asked to draw a number from a "hat" the numbers will be 4, 6 or 8 this will determine their starting positions

Feature Race

If the top qualifier draws the 8 marble for example the top 8 qualifiers will be inverted. Only 20 cars will start the feature race. The exception being if there is 21 cars still running after the heats. Feature races will be a minimum of 25 and a maximum of 30 laps

Rules

The current NASR racing rules will apply.

Bad Weather

If bad weather forces or any unforeseen circumstances, the feature may be reduced by either the track promoter or the chief steward. When a roosters cup round is cancelled due to weather or other circumstances prior to the start of the race meeting, no prize money or tow will be paid. We reserve the right to reschedule the event to another date.





Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters. At the conclusion of the feature race the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters will align their cars on the track facing the spectators in a diagonal position or as directed by the officials to receive their trophies.
